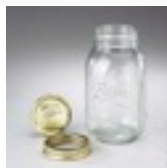

RISE AGAINST HUNGER COLLECTION JARS

OCTOBER 1

We are now just **two** months away from our first-ever sponsored meal packing event for Rise Against Hunger on October 1st. This past February all FIPC families received an empty, labeled quart jar for the purpose of receiving contributions. Each family was asked to make contributions in a way that was most meaningful and doable for them. Please plan on turning in your donation jar on OCTOBER 1st. The monies received in the jars will be used exclusively to purchase as many \$75 water-filter systems as possible. These filter systems provide 100-gallons of clean water per day for TEN years to those who have no other resource for clean water!!!



October 1st will include World Communion Worship service, a monthly PYC-mission luncheon, THEN the meal packing event. We need volunteers of ALL ages, there is something **everyone** can do that contributes to the project. We will be packing 10,000 meals in about 2-hours!
