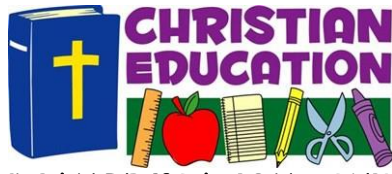

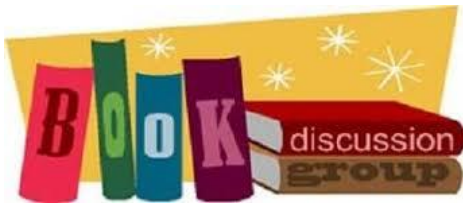
AUGUST 5 ~ CHRISTIAN EDUCATION & CHILDREN'S DIVISION

Long-time member, the late Edna Thomason Rouse, graciously gave of her time and talent as the volunteer pianist of FIPC; faithfully being at the piano on Sunday morning for at least 50-years. Upon Edna's retirement and as a perpetual honorarium of her faithfulness, FIPC began awarding a \$500 annual scholarship to a deserving music-major college student in partnership with Fountain Inn Music Club with the music club facilitating the selection and award. This year's recipient is violinist *Mary Katherine Brown* who is a student at Bob Jones University. The Fountain Inn Music Club matches the \$500 received from FIPC; thus awarding \$1,000 annually. The scholarship has a selection process that includes interview, audition and letter of application with stated intent of career and need of the scholarship monies.
