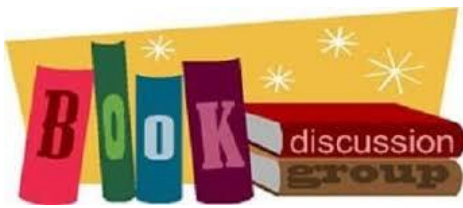
JOAN ROSKOS JONES
