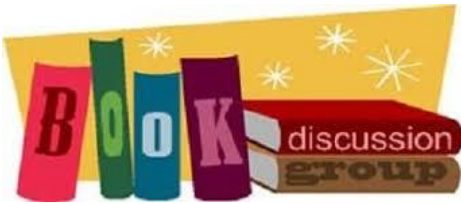

- 2) The second option to registering is stopping by the registration table outside the narthex before or after worship on September 23rd.
