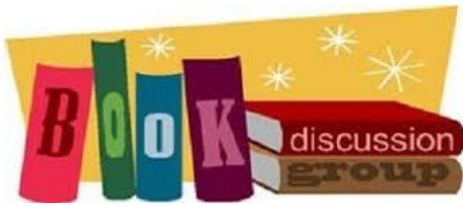

Rise Again Hunger Report

During the most recent Foothills Presbytery quarterly meeting, commissioners and delegates participated in a Rise Against Hunger meal-packing event before beginning the regular Presbytery meeting. As of 5/19/18, a shipping container holding 285,120 meals were shipped to Madagascar for their hunger partners, Adventist Development and Relief Agency. Ending hunger is only possible if we continue to grow the movement. Since 2005, volunteers have helped RAH distribute over 310 million meals worldwide. We can end hunger by 2030, but we can't do it without you. October 7th is FIPC's opportunity to help end hunger. Please register TODAY.

1) Go on-line at: <http://events.stophungernow.org/FountainInn2018> and follow the prompts to fill out the information. You will be given the option to make an online monetary donation, but you do not have to make a donation to sign up. You can skip that step, and we will still have you in our count to help pack meals at the event. **Please register your children individually; as there isn't a way to enter entire family.** Don't be concerned about sharing your email address; this is used as a reminder notice the week prior to event. **Please understand, it greatly helps those planning if you register online rather than Option # 2 below; "pen & paper".**

2) The second option to registering is stopping by the registration table outside the narthex before or after worship on September 16th or 23rd.

Also, if your student needs community service hours for school/scout organizations, volunteering for Rise Against Hunger is a great way to earn those hours! They are welcome to include a Classmate who must also be registered.
