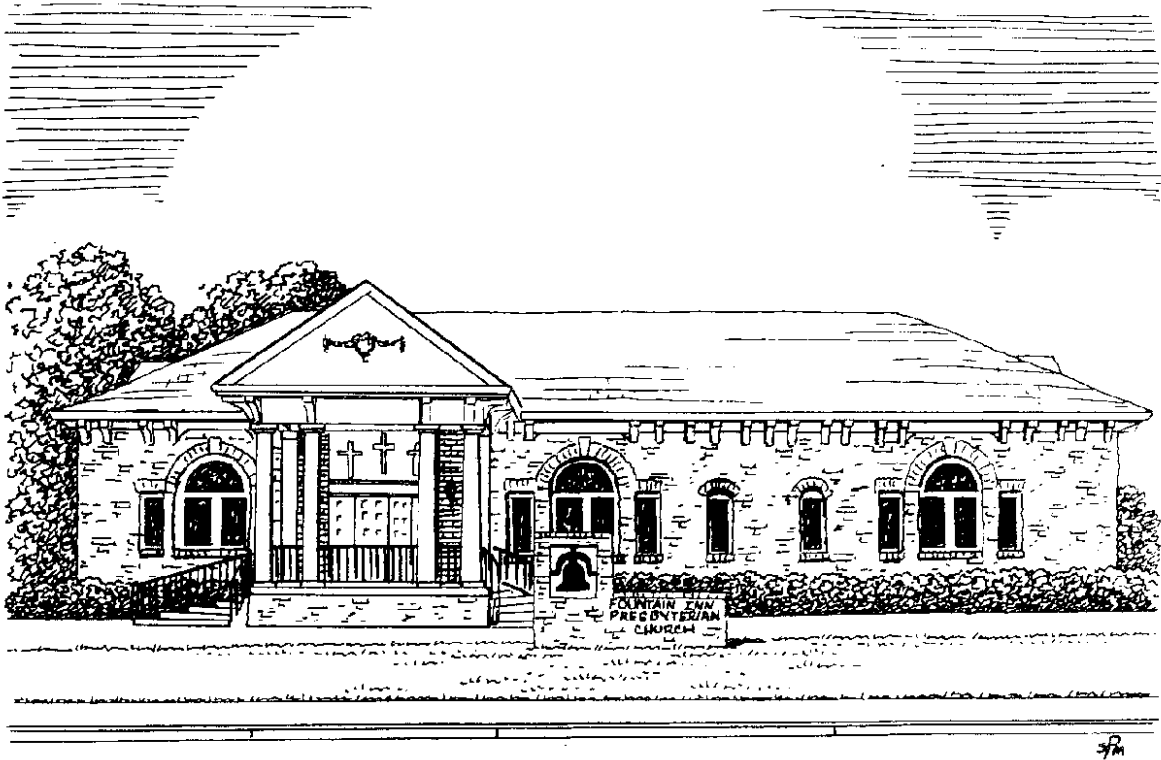

**MEDICAL MISSIONS, INC.** will be traveling to Iquitos, Peru on their 2019 Amazon Mission Trip from April 27<sup>th</sup> – May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Participant's cost is \$1000.00 PLUS airfare. Trip cost covers ground transportation, double occupancy lodging and meals. Travelers are responsible for miscellaneous tips and in transit meals. \$500 is due on or before Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> and \$500 is due by Mar. 15<sup>th</sup>. \*Price may vary depending on the cost of airline tickets. This 8 Day Mission Trip is to primitive villages deep in the heart of the Amazon rainforest in Iquitos, Peru. It is located 2300 miles from the mouth of the Amazon River and is one of the most

remote areas in the world. You will work with other volunteers to continue to expand Medical Mission's projects in Iquitos and other remote villages. Opportunities include working with SCOTA (Special Children of the Amazon) school for handicapped children teaching Bible School, English classes, medical work or light construction projects. The skill necessary is a heartfelt desire to help the very poor.
