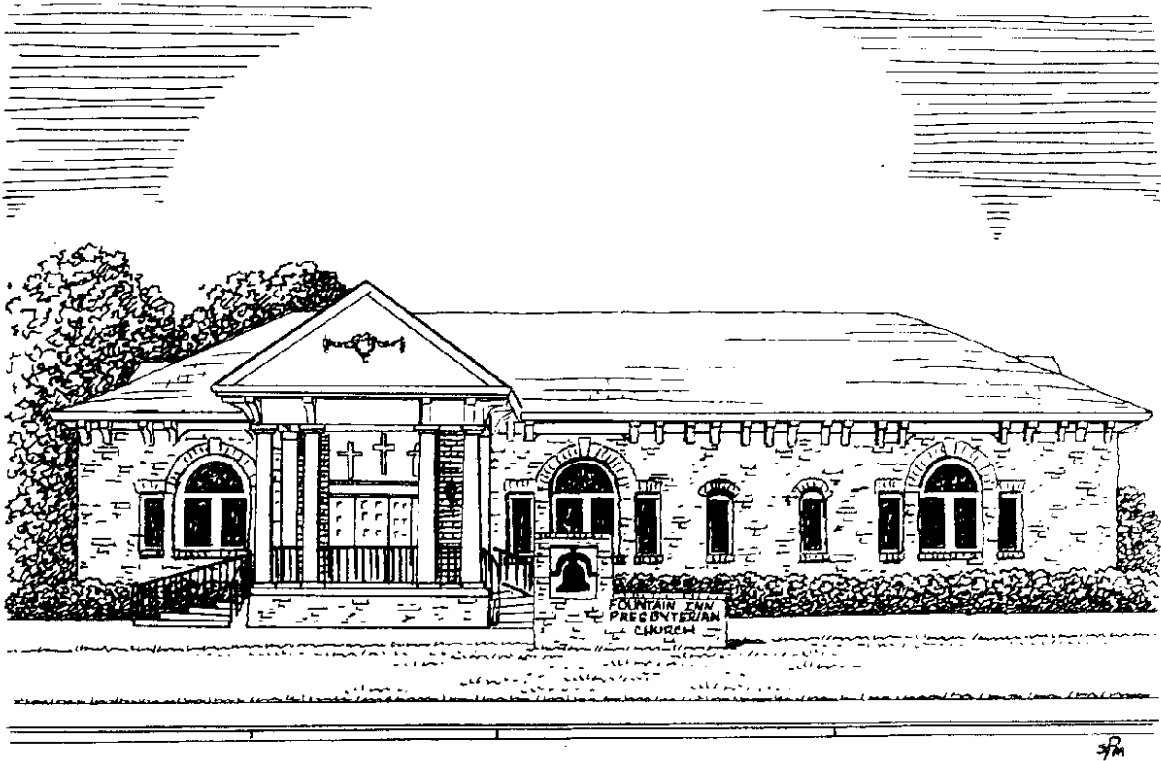

**As the new treasurer for Fountain Inn Presbyterian Church**, I would like to begin by thanking the congregation for their continued faithful stewardship, and to take a moment to thank you for this opportunity to serve as your treasurer. In my role as treasurer it is my obligation to inform the session and the congregation of our current financial status.

Last year FIPC ended the year with the operating budget at a deficit of \$24,675.00.

The deficit was covered by money that was an unallocated surplus in the checking account and reduced our cash holdings.

At the end of April 2019, we have collected \$77,880.69, while we have spent \$96,062.97.

This leaves a current shortfall in the operating budget of \$18,182.28.

This is actual giving related to actual expenses.

Our hope is that between now and the end of 2019 the tithes, offerings, and special gifts of the members and friends will make up the current shortfall. If you have any questions feel free to contact me.
