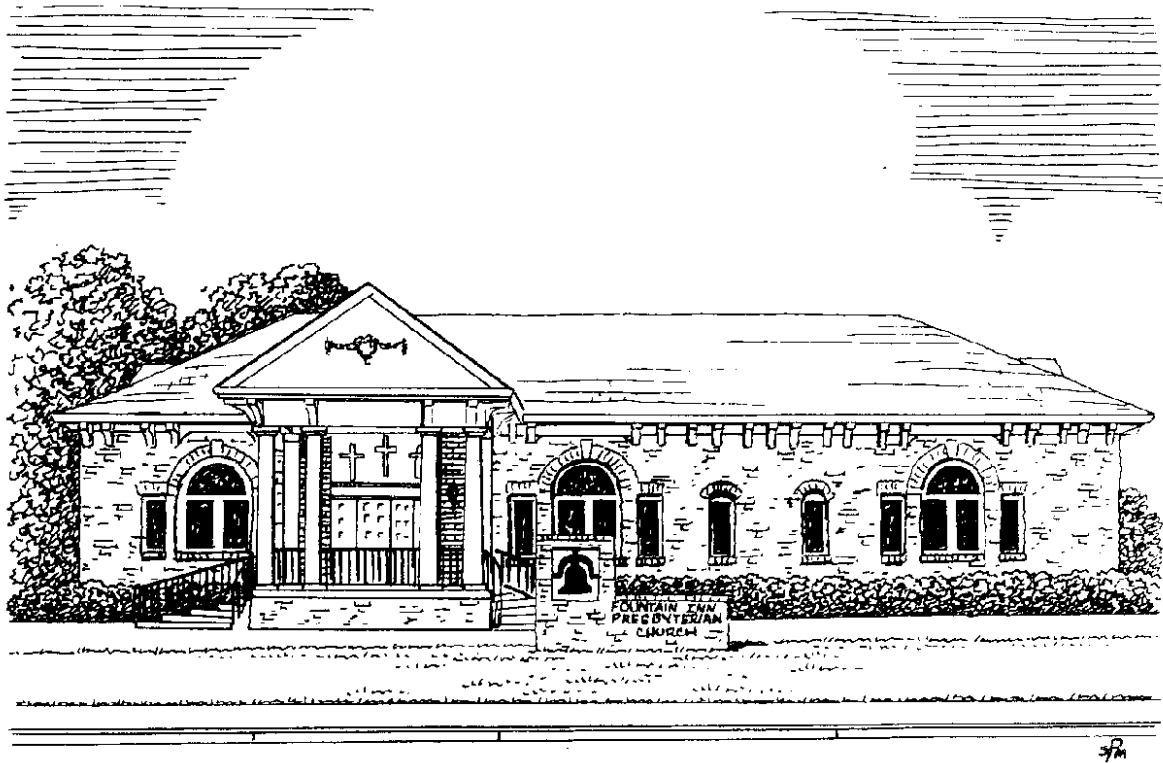

**Blessing of the Backpacks** During Children's Time during worship today we are asking all students, pre-school, kindergarten, elementary, middle, high school and college to participate in the Blessing of the Backpacks as they return to their classrooms. Bring your backpack forward for this special time of blessing and you will receive a special tag to remind you that God is with you at school.

**Prayers for Students** Today all adult members of the congregation have the opportunity to pray for our students as they return to their classrooms; prayers for growth, safety, happiness, wisdom, patience and love. From pre-school to college, all students will have a personalized "schoolhouse" placed in a bowl on the communion table.
